



PEACOCK SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- Scholarship seminar, workshop or other activity should be related to specific business of applicant or improving the applicant's general business skills.
- Scholarship funds are to be used for registration and/or workshop fees or materials, not travel or accommodations.
- Scholarship funds are not to be used for WBO-initiated workshops or training sessions where WBO is offering a lower unit cost for its members.
- WBO membership class levels Active, Sustaining, and Non-Profit are eligible to apply for Peacock Scholarship. Provisional, Honorary, and Associate levels are not eligible to apply.
- WBO member may receive scholarship award once every twenty-four (24) months per registered membership. In the event that several applications are received at the same time, priority will be given to the applicant who has never been awarded the scholarship over one who has, even if said scholarship was received more than twenty-four (24) months prior to the current application.
- Scholarships will be funded upon receipt of the completed Scholarship Packet, which includes (a) this application and (b) proof of registration for the educational activity, and/or training brochure or other information regarding the training.
- The scholarship application and supporting materials must be received no sooner than 90 days prior to the seminar, workshop or other activity. Post-event applications are not eligible. Applications may be emailed to admin@wbonfl.org or mailed to the WBO Administrative Office address listed below.
- The WBO Board Secretary will review all applications, and qualified applicants shall be recommended and/or presented to the Board of Directors for approval.
- For consideration by the Board of Directors each month, the application and supporting materials should be mailed to the WBO Administrative offices on or before the 1st of each calendar month.
- For the current Fiscal Year, a maximum of twelve (12) scholarships will be awarded. Each individual scholarship will be limited to a maximum of \$150.
- Once a scholarship is approved, the recipient will be notified by the WBO Board Secretary and invited to the next monthly dinner meeting to accept their scholarship check.
